## Suspect Subtly, With Honor and Respect - Rabbi Yissocher Frand

Here's a brilliant *shtickle Torah* from the present-day Tolner Rebbe of Yerushalayim, Rav Yitzchak Menachem Weinberg.

Avraham Avinu offers his visitors the opportunity to wash their feet and rest up. Rashi explains that Avraham Avinu thought that they were Arabs who bow down to the dust of their feet. Rashi also notes here that Lot had no such concern when he, in Sodom, offered these same guests lodging first, and only afterwards the opportunity to wash their feet.

Later on, Rashi explains that Lot said, "Take lodging and wash your feet" – in that order – because he preferred the visitors to look dusty so that his neighbors wouldn't suspect him of being hospitable.

The Tolner's first question is how do we resolve Rashi's two contradictory comments about Lot? His second question is why does Rashi comment about *Lot* when discussing *Avraham's* reception of the visitors? Save it for the discussion of *Lot's* reception of the visitors! His third question is why does generous Avraham tell his visitors to take a *little* water with which to wash their feet?

The Tolner Rebbe answers beautifully. In Maseches Derech Eretz, Rav Yehoshua teaches that "All people should be in your eyes as if they were robbers, but honor them like Rabban Gamliel (the Nasi)."

Avraham Avinu was demonstrating how to *properly* be suspicious of one's guests. An offer of a *lot* of water would arouse their suspicion. His offer of a *little* water would not. The intent of Rashi's mention of Lot at this point is to show that Avraham's method of addressing the problem of avodah zara was so subtle that Lot missed it.

There is no contradiction between Rashi's comments about Lot, because both of Lot's reasons are true. Lot really did not offer them a chance to wash first, because he wanted to make them look like they just arrived, as Rashi says over there. Avraham offered only a little water in order to be subtle about his suspicions that they worshipped the dust on their feet. And the reason why Rashi also contrasts Avraham with Lot over here is in order to point out that Avraham kept his suspicion of his guests so subtle that Lot did not even realize what was going on.

With this approach, the Tolner Rebbe says an incredible insight:

Rav Yehoshua and Rabban Gamliel had a history between them. In Maseches Rosh HaShanah, Rav Yehoshua and Rabban Gamliel calculated different dates for Yom Kippur. Rabban Gamliel ordered Rav Yehoshua to appear before him with his staff and money on the day that Rav Yehoshua calculated to be Yom Kippur. The Gerer Rebbe asks why Rabban Gamliel didn't order Rav Yehoshua to eat a sandwich. The answer is that, not wanting to *crush* Rav Yehoshua, he ordered him to violate a *rabbinic* prohibition (muktzeh), not a *Torah* prohibition. The Tolner Rav says that Rav Yehoshua's teaching is correctly understood as "All people should be in your eyes as if they were robbers, but honor them like Rabban Gamliel (the Nasi) **honored me**. There is no mitzvah to crush people, removing their dignity.
