Hashem Appreciates Jews Who Put Their Neck Out for Other Jews

"Pharaoh will say to the Children of Israel, 'They are imprisoned in the land, the Wilderness has locked them in.'" (Shemos 14:3)

How would Pharaoh speak to Bnei Yisrael? They had either perished during the darkness or left Mitzrayim!

Therefore, most Meforshei HaChumash do not translate the word "*li*" here to mean "*to*," but rather as "*about*." According to Targum Yonosan ben Uziel, however, Pharaoh spoke to Dasan and Aviram – two Jews who remained in Mitzrayim.

As is well known, Dasan and Aviram were terrible antagonists of Moshe Rabbeinu. They were wicked men who gave Moshe constant tzores. Apparently, they stuck around in Mitzrayim, not wanting to leave with Moshe. Pharaoh was addressing *them*.

But how were these two wicked people still alive? The Torah says that Bnei Yisrael left Mitzrayim "*chamushim*" (Shemos 13:18). According to some Medrashim, this means that only one fifth ('*chomesh*') of the Jews left Mitzrayim – the righteous ones. Eighty percent were found unworthy and died during Makkas Choshech. So how is it that they lived to tell the tale and survived all the way into the Midbar, until the rebellion of Korach more than a year later? What was their merit that granted them this 'longevity'?

The Maharil Diskin says an amazing thing. Dasan and Aviram had a zechus in that they were taskmasters (*shotrim*) in Mitzrayim. The overseers were Egyptians, but the people who actually dealt with the Jewish slaves were these taskmasters. The overseers did not whip the slaves. No, they whipped the Jewish taskmasters, who in turn ensured maximum productivity from the slaves.

The Maharil Diskin says that the Ribono shel Olam has a soft spot in His heart *kivyachol* for a Jew who suffers on behalf of other Jews. Dasan and Aviram were wicked, but they had this one incredible merit. It protected them from the widespread death during the Choshech, and it protected them from punishment for not wanting to leave Mitzrayim.
